

Level 2 C.I.E.H Emergency First Aid at Work Course Content

It also covers the opportunity to practise the skills needed to administer first aid to a casualty who is:

- Unconscious
- Not breathing
- Choking
- Bleeding from a wound
- In shock
- Suffering from a minor injury

Upon completion of the Level 2 First Aid course candidates will receive a certificate valid for three years. They will then need to re-take the course again (the HSE strongly recommend that all first aiders do an annual ½ day refresher course to help them maintain their basic skills & keep up to date with any changes to first aid procedures).

There is also a 3 Day First Aid at Work course available.
